



THE MALAYSIAN GOLF ASSOCIATION STATEMENT REGARDING THE RESTRICTED MOVEMENT MEASURE ON COVID-19 OUTBREAK

In line with the recent directive from the Malaysian Government on the **RESTRICTED MOVEMENT MEASURE** (PERINTAH KAWALAN PERGERAKAN) on all NON-ESSENTIAL services including the golf sector, the Malaysian Golf Association (MGA) will cease operation from 18th March to 31st March, 2020. MGA will start its operation on 1st April 2020 or until further notice from the Government.

The MGA would also encourage our Affiliates to adhere to the directive from the Government and to cease operations and to advise your employees to remain at home during the Restricted Movement Measure from 18th March to 31st March 2020. If any golf club wishes to conduct maintenance works during this time, it has to be at each club's discretion and to follow the guidelines set up by the Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia. MGA however would like to strongly encourage golf club to cease operations completely to assist the Government to contain this Covid-19 outbreak.
