2022 Asia-Pacific Senior Amateur Championship

TERM OF COMPETITION



1. Championship Procedure

1.1 The Championship comprise of Men and Women event which run concurrently.

The Championship will be played over 54 holes of stroke play at Kota Permai Golf & Country Club, Selangor, Malaysia.

Round 1 – Tuesday, 22nd November

Round 2 – Wednesday 23rd November

Round 3 – Thursday 24th November

NB: There will be no cut.

1.2 The winner will be the Asia-Pacific Senior Amateur Champion and will receive a Championship Gold Memento and hold the Y.A. Bhg. Tun Abdul Hamid Omar Cup for one year. The runner-up will receive a Silver Memento.

1.3 In the event of a tie for after three rounds for the Championship, the winner will be decided by a hole by hole play-off to take place immediately after the final round has concluded. Unless the Championship Committee determines otherwise, other positions will be decided by count back in accordance with The R&A's Matching Score Cards procedure.

2. Asia Pacific Golf Confederation Teams Event

2.1 Each country may nominate 1 (one) men's team and 1 (one) women's team. Men's team comprised of a maximum of FOUR players per team and women's team comprised of a maximum THREE players, all of whom must be citizens or Nationals of the country they represent. Team entry forms will be emailed to each APGC Member country.

2.2 The winning team will be determined by the lowest aggregate of the THREE best gross scores for Men event and TWO best scores for Women event from each round.

2.3 Disqualification of a team member under the Rules of Golf in any round will not be effective for any subsequent round of the Asia Pacific Golf Confederation Teams Event unless the Championship Committee determines otherwise.

2.4 In the event of a tie joint winners will be declared.

2.5 Members of the winning team(s) will receive mementos.

3. Championship Committee

3.1. The Championship Committee will comprise the APGC Championship Committee Chairman, Tournament Director, Chief Referee, and one representative of Malaysian Golf Association.

3.2. In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.

3.3. The Championship Committee will have the sole management and control of the Championship, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.

3.4. The Championship Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship will be final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within ten (10) minutes of the conclusion of the relevant day's play.

3.5. The decision of the Championship Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.

4. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules as published by the Championship Committee

5. Entries

5.1 Eligible players are amateurs who have reached their 55th birthday for Men event and 50th birthday for Women event by 1st November 2022 and; whose Handicap does not exceed the handicap limit for their age category at the time of entry, or who are an exempt player as detailed in Condition 6. The exact handicap certified at the date of entry will be used for ballot purposes.

Handicap Index Limits are as follows:

Men Event

Group A (55-59 years) – 13.4

Group B (60-64 years) – 15.4

Group C (65-69 years) – 17.4

Group D (70 years and above) – no limit

Women Event

Group A (50-54 years) – 15.4

Group B (55-59 years) – 17.4 **Group C (60 years and above) – no limit**

5.2 Entrance Fee USD 400.00 The Entry Fee includes the following:

- Championship Entry (plus Practice Round)
- Transport from Hotel to Course & return
- Opening Reception (Welcome Cocktail)
- Prize Giving Ceremony and Farewell Dinner

- Practice Balls for Championship Rounds and
- Practice Round (prior to the round: 30 balls)
- Championship Goodies
- KLIA/KLIA2 Airport pick-up and drop-off (specific date only, see separate form)

5.3 Entries shall be made via the official entry form only.

5.4 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, and shall acknowledge to that effect in Entry Form.

5.5 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the Championship age categories (Men Event: Group A – 45, Group B – 25, Group C – 15 & Group D – 5), (Women Event: Group A – 25, Group B – 10, & Group C – 5), applications from those higher handicap competitors not exempt from a handicap ballot as detailed in Condition 6 shall be decided by a ballot at the discretion of the Championship Organizing Committee. If any Championship age category has fewer entries than their maximum filed, the balance will be allotted to other Championship age categories at the Championship Committee's discretion. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur.

5.6 Entry form must be sent to MGA (by email) by 5:00pm Thursday 31st October 2022. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.

5.7 Entry fee must be paid in full upon submission of entry form.

6. Exemptions

Exemptions from a handicap ballot for the 2022 Asia-Pacific Senior Amateur Championship will be granted to the following; (**Note** – Where applicable, it is the sole responsibility of the player to ensure the Championship Committee has received notification of his exempt status. Should the Championship Committee not be so advised, that player will be deemed to be a non-exempt player.)

6.1 Team members – Asia Pacific Golf Confederation Team Event.

6.2 Players exempted by the Championship Committee (maximum 3).

6.3 Senior Amateur Champions of APGC Member Countries 2011-2022.

6.4 Previous APGC Senior Amateur Champions.

7. Television and Media

All rights for televising live, television recordings or for any visual or electronic reproduction of the Championship are reserved only to the APGC and may only be made under license.

8. Practice Round

Monday 21st November 2022

9. Pace of Play

Pace of play will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contributed to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

10. Registration

Competitors must register between 8:00 and 16:00 at Kota Permai Golf & Country Club on Monday 21st November 2022. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the Championship.

11. Database of Competitors' Details

The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by the APGC. This data may be utilized by APGC or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time-to-time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, an APGC e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of APGC events, or information about events conducted by APGC-approved bodies. Upon receipt by APGC of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
